To whom it may concern,

I am writing to clarify one point on my Graduate visa application.

Paragraph GR1.5 of the Immigration Rules states:

“GR 1.5. If the applicant has in the 12 months before the date of application completed a course of studies in the UK for which they have been awarded a scholarship or sponsorship by a Government or international scholarship agency **covering both fees and living costs** for study in the UK, they must provide written consent to the application from that Government or agency.”

(Delete the following paragraph if sponsor provided £1136 or more per month for living costs) I was previously receiving financial sponsorship from **NAME OF GOVERNMENT SPONSOR OR INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP AGENCY**. However, the stipend that I received for my living costs was £**AMOUNT** per month. This was not sufficient to cover the £1136 per month stipulated by the immigration rules and Student visa caseworker guidance.

(Delete the following paragraph if sponsor provided full tuition fees). The total tuition fees for my course were £**AMOUNT**. My sponsorship from **NAME OF GOVERNMENT SPONSOR OR INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP AGENCY** only covered £**AMOUNT** of this tuition fee.

Therefore, this section of the rules and guidance should not apply to me as my sponsorship did not cover my living costs.
