We led and managed a call to researchers in the university.

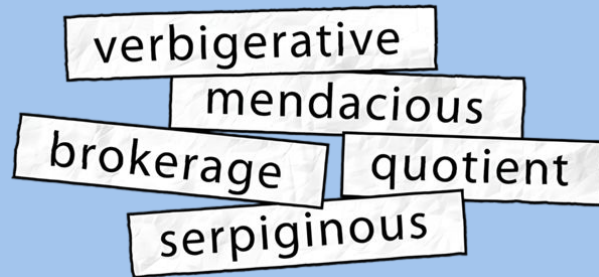
They could apply for funds to work on a project with Disabled People's organisations

What we did?

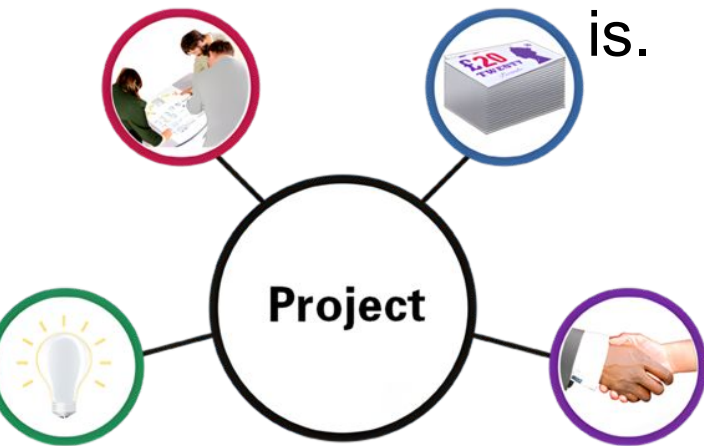
We looked at **The Researcher Concordat** to see how it can develop the careers of disabled researchers
