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The Cross Cutting Theme used all the information that was found to create an action plan to include Disabled Staff at the University of Sheffield.

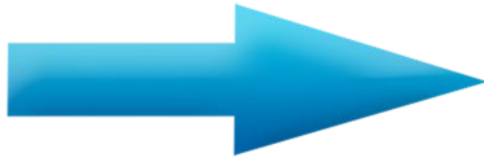


We are working with Professor John John Flint, University Deputy Vice President for Research to do this.
