Instructions for VLeBooks, ProQuest eBook Central (Read Online)

- Open the ebook you would like to be read to you. Select 'Read Online' and navigate to the page/chapter you would like to be read aloud.
- Open Read & Write from the start menu (or download from the software centre).



• The Read and Write toolbar should appear on the screen.



• Make sure you are in the 'Reading Features' Read & Write toolbar by clicking on the drop down arrow next to the 'rw' symbol on the right hand side, hover over Current Toolbar and select Reading Features.

• Select the Screenshot reader icon and then use the cursor to draw a rectangle around the text you want to be read aloud. It should now be read aloud automatically. You can do this repeatedly.
