ClaroRead, which is available via the software centre on all networked PCs, has a number of features that can make documents easier to digest.

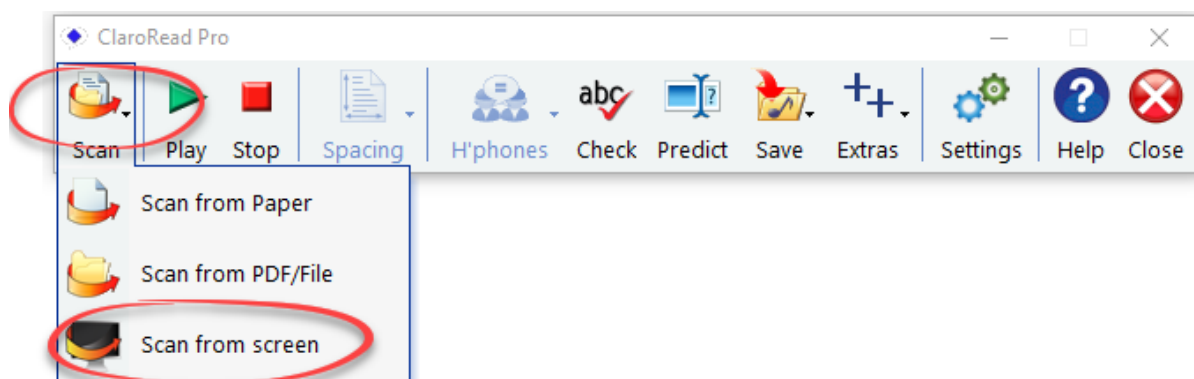
## Instructions for Dawsonera VLeBooks, ProQuest eBooks Central (Read Online)

- Open the ebook you would like to be read to you.
- Select 'Read Online' and navigate to the page/chapter you would like to be read aloud.
- Open ClaroRead Pro from the start menu (or download from the software centre).

The ClaroRead Pro Toolbar should appear on the screen.



- On the ClaroRead Toolbar, select the 'Scan' icon and select 'Scan from screen' from the dropdown menu.

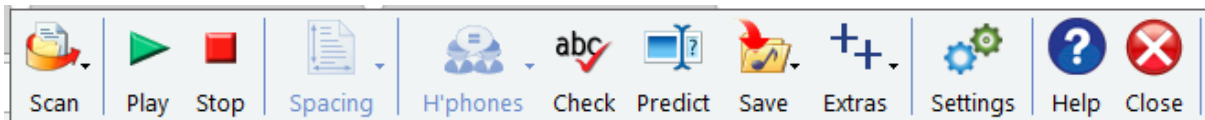


- Using the cursor draw a box around the text you would like to be read aloud to you. It should now read to you automatically.

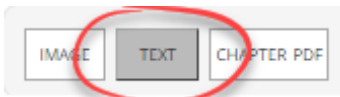
## Instructions for ACLS Humanity E-Books (Read Online)

- Open ClaroRead Pro from the start menu (or download from the software centre).

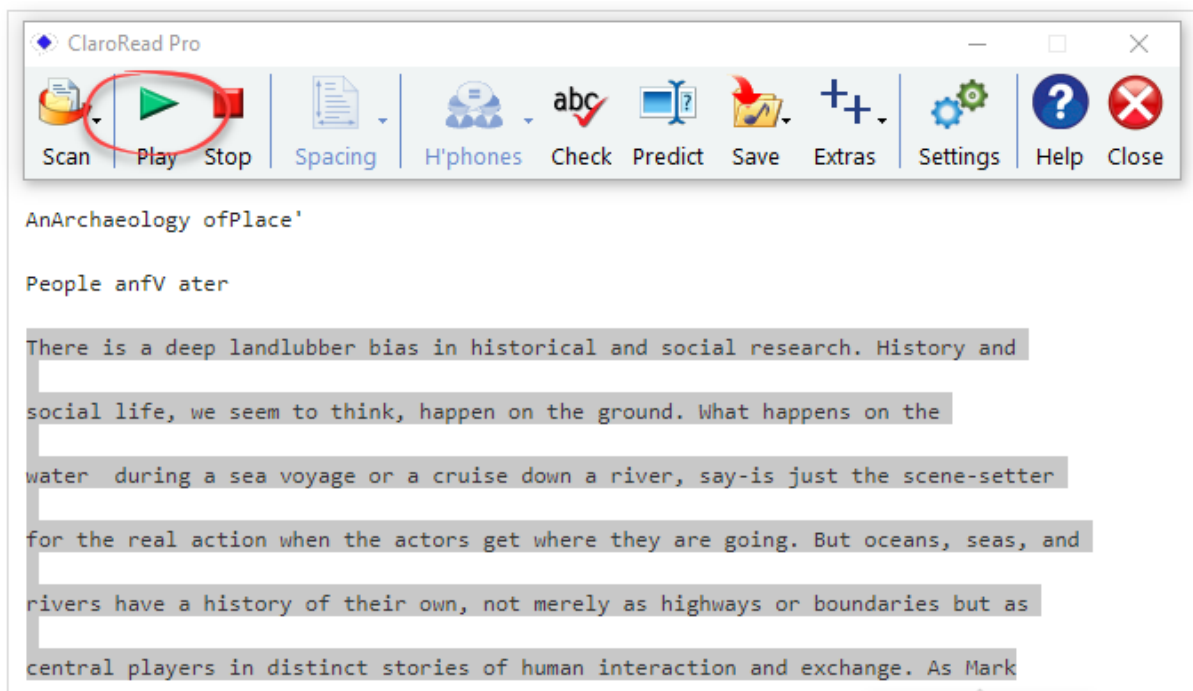
The ClaroRead Pro Toolbar should appear on the screen.

## Instructions for ProQuest eBook Central- Chapter download

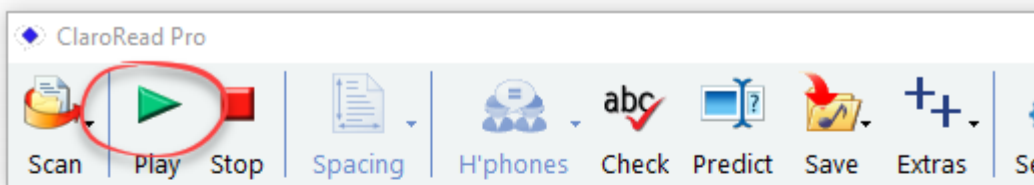
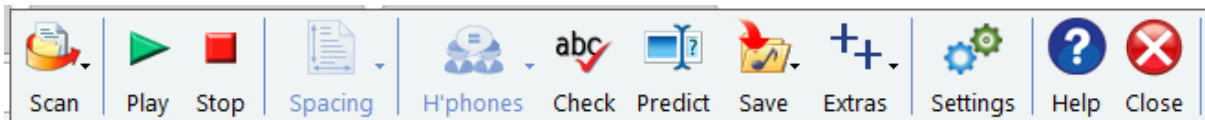
- Open the ebook you would like to be read to you.

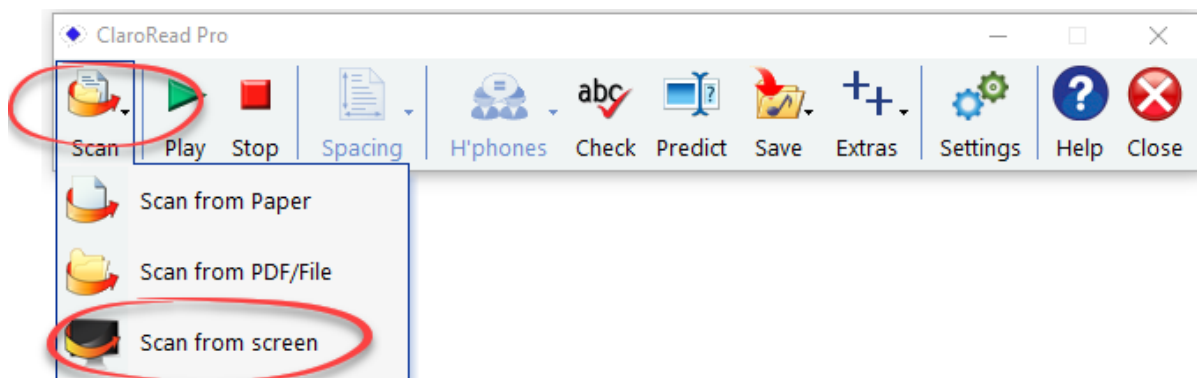
## Instructions for Adobe Digital Editions
