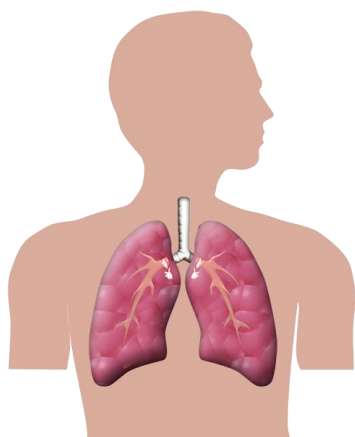


Crippling Breath: Be Part of Our Breathing Research Team!

What is Crippling Breath?

- A new project about breathing and ventilation (breathing with machines)
- Lasts for 5 years



What does 'Crippling' mean?

- 'Crippling' comes from the words of disabled people who fight for their rights.
- Crippling means instead of thinking of disability as only bad things, it helps us imagine it as good, exciting, and fun!
