Permission for one final attempt as part of a repeat year would require the approval of the Dental School Progress Committee. A student who is given approval for one final attempt as part of a repeat year must retake all the BOHS&CP Examinations. A student who fails to pass any part of the BOHS&CP Examinations will be required to resit the relevant components.

Successful completion of the BOHS&CP, IOHS&CP and AOHS&CP Examinations will satisfy the requirements for the Diploma in Dental Hygiene and Dental Therapy and will entitle the holder to apply for registration as a Dental Hygienist and Dental Therapist with the General Dental Council.

On the recommendation of the Examiners, the Diploma in Dental Hygiene and Dental Therapy may be awarded with Distinction. In considering recommendations for the award of Distinction, Examiners will take into account students performance in the IOHS&CP and AOHS&CP Examinations.
